Forklift Training Tips

It is important that all workplaces making use of forklifts have the following checklist or one equivalent on the premises. If all of the safety regulations are being followed, each of these questions must be answered with a "yes". A "no" to whichever question indicates a procedural flaw that could lead to accident, injury or damage to machine.

- 1) Is the forklift operating area separated from pedestrian traffic?
- 2) Is pedestrian access to forklift travel areas restricted by barriers?
- 3) Are pedestrian walkways well marked and provided?
- 4) Are "forklift in operation" signs visibly clear?
- 5) There are mirrors provided at blind spots for operators and pedestrians?
- 6) Are alterations to daily lift truck schedules communicated to all affected workers?
- 7) The lift truck tires being utilized are suitable for all operating surfaces?
- 8) Is the seatbelt being utilized?
- 9) The forklift seat is in good condition?
- 10) Is a regular forklift maintenance schedule adhered to?
- 11) Is an annual forklift certification and inspection carried out?
- 12) Is the kind of forklift appropriate for the job?
- 13) Does forklift has a load chart that is readable?
- 14) Could the operators understand and read the load chart?
- 15) Does the chart list the safe capacity for various attachments and uses?
- 16) Do the forklift warning devices work properly?
- 17) The speed operating control device is secured properly?
- 18) The lift truck overhead cage is fitted properly?
- 19) Have all forklift operators acquired certification?
- 20) Warning signs and speed limits are being observed?
- 21) The operators have current training for the forklifts being used?
- 22) Forklift operators understand their responsibilities to report the damage to the equipment and other forklift accidents?
- 23) Prior to the machine being operated, the pre-test checklist is being reviewed each and every day?
